Laurie's Story

It's been five years since I escaped, and I am still recovering. My name is Laurie, and I am a mother of three—my daughter was 2, my son was 1, and my youngest was just 9 months old when everything happened. For over seven years, I endured an abusive relationship that took a severe toll on my well-being and my children's safety. My partner's short temper and anger escalated into violence. He began lashing out at me, and eventually, he targeted my children.

One night, the abuse became unbearable. He yelled, threw things, and hit both me and the kids. The noise alerted a neighbor, who called the police. Even then, I felt ashamed, as though I'd failed my children, but I knew I had to get them to safety.

A friend told me about Yellow Brick House in York Region. At first, I hesitated, thinking a shelter would be a terrible place for my kids. But with no other options, I called—and it turned out to be the best decision I ever made.

Yellow Brick House welcomed us with open arms. We stayed for two months, during which time the staff helped us heal, assisted with housing and legal matters, and guided me in building a new path for our family.

Today, as I watch my children play safely in our new home, I feel immense gratitude. Thanks to Yellow Brick House, we escaped our darkest days and started over. I will always be thankful for the kindness and support we received when we needed it most.
